

MaFEA – Making Future Education Accessible

Setting ThingLink content settings

- 1. Open the ThingLink content that you want to adjust
- 2. Open the settings from the three points. You will find this on the right-hand side HERE.



- a. **Privacy settings**. Here you will find 4 options. Personally, I often use first **Unlisted** or **Private** and then when the icon is ready, I change it either to be visible only to the **Organization** (in that case the people have to be logged in) or simply as **Public** so everyone can find and access to the photo.
- b. **Rename.** I recommend that you change the name of that image first. (Often there is just a numbers).
 - a. Note. If you wish to have a text to this image, it must be done before importing the image into the ThingLink platform.
- c. **Move to folder.** Move the ThingLink content to a folder.
- d. **Statistic.** Statistics on the ThingLink content.
- e. **Clone.** The cloning button is automatically on all **platforms**, unless you have specifically changed it from the settings that it is not possible.
- f. **Replace background.** Allows you to replace the uploaded background image.
- g. **Download.** ThingLink content can be stored and viewed without an Internet connection!
- h. **Repost.** You can report this media for abusive, violent or sexual content, and ThingLink staff will take a look at it.
- i. **Move to trash.** Move the ThingLink content to trash.

Give rights for others to clone your images or not


From the profile setting, you can allow others to either clone your images or not. However, you can always clone your own images.

Note. Cloning permission is done not one picture at a time but one profile at a time.
