

### Installing the HoloLens2 – v1

It is a step-by-step plan to set up the HoloLens2.

#### Before starting the HoloLens 2

- 1. Charge the HoloLens by using the USB-C cable.
- 2. Fitment of the HoloLens on your head.
  - You can hold your eyeglaces on.
  - Put the brow pad on your forehead. The back band is on the back of the head.
  - Adjust the headband by turning the adjustment wheel when needed.
  - You can detach the overhead strap to shorten or losing it.




- 3. Use the HoloLens in a safe space with no obstructions.
- 4. For using the HoloLens you need a network connection. You can use a Wi-Fi of ethernet. You can use an open of a password-protected network. Connection with a network navigating to a website doesn't work.
- 5. You need a Microsoft account. You can go to account.microsoft.com to set up a free account if you don't have one.




#### Starting the HoloLens 2 the first time

1) Start the HoloLens by pushing the button at the right side of the back of the head.



- 2) The first time the HoloLens is started, you have to set up Windows Holographic.
- 3) You have to push on the Microsoft logo button. Than you have to go through the following steps:



a. Select your language




b. Select your region




- c. calibrate the HoloLens to your eyes. (you can skip it and do it later)
- d. follow the several steps to calibrate your eyes








4) You have to connect to the internet, that can be Wi-Fi or ethernet connection






5) In the next step the HoloLens will search and appley an Autopilot profile. Nothing has to be done



6) Click to accept the Windows License Agreement




7) You have to sign in to your user account.





8) You can also sign-in with your iris. You may also skip it.








9) To log in you have to setup a PIN











10) You can also enable speech to use your voice for commands, dictations and app interactions.



11) You can enable your location.



12) Next step is to select the telemetry level.



13) The last step to complete the setup is to learn the start gesture.





After you have completed the setup you enter the navigation from Windows 10. It is interesting to check out the Tips app for the hands-on tutorials for hand interactions. You can use the start gesture or say "Go to Start" and select "Tips".
