Casting a Pico 4 Enterprise headset view

It can be very difficult to assist students who are using a Pico 4 Enterprise headset when the teacher cannot see the student's view. A first response is usually for the student to remove the headset so the teacher can put it on and understand what assistance is needed before returning the headset to the student. This can be disruptive and quickly becomes frustrating.

Casting the headset view to another screen, enables others to see the headset view. Below are the available options:

Note! Some schools' wifi connections will not allow casting or allow devices to find each other. Ask your IT -department for help if these options do not work for you.

Casting to an internet browser on a computer

- 1. Ensure both the computer and the Pico 4 Enterprise headset are connected to the same Wi-Fi network.
- 2. On the Pico 4 Enterprise headset, open the home menu by pressing the Home-button (O) on the controller.
- 3. Select the quick settings.
