### Creating and logging into a ThingLink account – v1

#### Introduction

This guide will help teachers or students to log into a ThingLink account. You will need:

1. An invite code.
2. An existing free ThingLink account, or to create a new free ThingLink account.

ThingLink accounts can have different licences. The most common are Free, Premium and Enterprise. Your free-licence ThingLink account can be added to an organisation (school) and use all the extra features that are included with that organisation's licence.

In the same way, your ThingLink account can also be removed from an organisation (school), and it will become a free-licence account again.

ThingLink accounts also have different roles. The most common are Administrator, Teacher and Student.

When you create your ThingLink account, you will be asked if you are a teacher or student. It is important that you select the correct role!

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### Creating a free ThingLink student account and joining a ThingLink organisation

1. Navigate to [ThingLink's eLearning pricing page](#).
2. Click on the Create Free Account -button.
3. Create your account:
  - a. using an email address and password, or
  - b. connecting an existing account of the following types: Office 365, Google, Clever, Facebook, Twitter.
  - c. **Do not use the invite code at this stage!**
  - d. **Good to know!** Remember which option you chose to sign up with and only use this option to log in to ThingLink from now on. If you try to log in using a different method, you will end up with multiple accounts.

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- You should now be on your ThingLink dashboard. Your account has now been created.

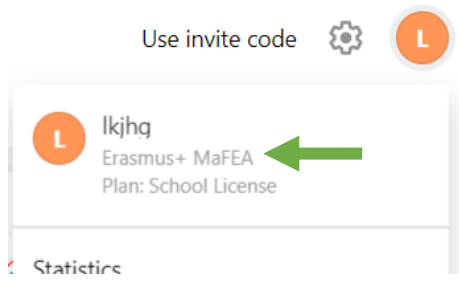

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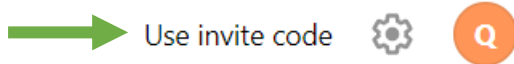


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## MaFEA – Making Future Education Accessible

### Accepting a ThingLink organisation invitation to an existing ThingLink account

1. If you have not already, log in to your free-license ThingLink account.
2. Click on the Use invite code -button.



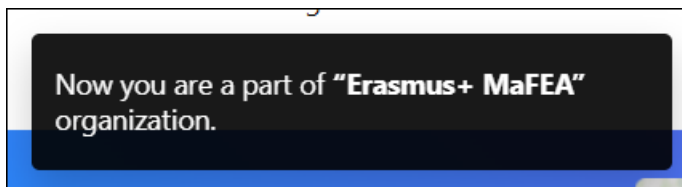
3. Type your invite code and click the Join -button.
